FIRST AID, MEDICINE & ALLERGIES

A first aid kit is available in the church office. If your child needs to take any medication, please take this medication at home before sending your child to HUM. No medicines will be kept at the church.

Children who have allergies or other medical conditions indicated on their registration forms will have their information on a list given to the crew leaders. HUM strives to accommodate a variety of food allergies. However, if you feel more comfortable sending your child with their own dinner, please bring it in a bag marked with their name and do not include any peanut/nut products.

DROP-OFF(5:15 pm-5:30 pm)

Please park and walk your child into the building. Check in tables are in the Narthex (preregistered participants can go straight to the BLUE table to check in). Once checked-in, participants can find their crew in the sanctuary. Please check in each night that you attend.

Crews will head to dinner at 5:30 pm.

PRESCHOOL PICK-UP(7:50 pm)

Preschool children will be dismissed after our preschool closing activities in the multipurpose room at 7:50pm. Crew leaders will release the children oneby-one at the conclusion of our closing. Anyone unfamiliar will be asked to show identification.

Parents can find out which crew number/color their child was assigned at the registration table. Feel free to watch our closing activities where we review the theme for the night along the back wall at 7:40 before before we begin our dismissal!

K-6th PICK-UP(8:00pm)

Children in K-6th grade will be dismissed after our closing activities in the sanctuary at 8:00pm. Crew leaders will release the children one-by-one from the hallway beside the sanctuary (by the registration table), one crew at a time. Anyone unfamiliar will be asked to show identification.

Parents can find out which crew number/color their child was assigned at the registration table. Feel free to watch our closing activities where we review the theme for the night in the sanctuary at 7:50 before heading back out to the narthex for dismissal!



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
